Another wonderful reading from Matthew's Gospel today (14²²⁻³³). We have the story of Peter walking on the water towards Jesus. THE VERY STRICT RULES FOR ATTENDING MASS.

- **DO NOT ATTEND** IF YOU HAVE ANY COVID-19 SYMPTOMS or HAVE BEEN IN CONTACT WITH AN INFECTED PERSON IN THE PREVIOUS 14 DAYS.
- A **MAXIMUM OF 20 CAN ATTEND A MASS.**
- SIT IN THE LABELED SEATS AS THEY ARE DESIGNED TO BE 2 METRES AWAY FROM OTHERS IN THE CHURCH. Keep **2 METRE DISTANCING** AT ALL TIMES.
- THERE IS A **ONE-WAY SYSTEM** AROUND THE CHURCH WHICH MUST BE FOLLOWED **AT ALL TIMES**
- FOR THE SAFETY OF OTHERS, AND TO REDUCE THE RISK OF CONTAMINATION, **NO CUTTING THROUGH OR ALONG THE BENCHES IS PERMITTED AT ANY TIME INCLUDING DURING COMMUNION, OR WHEN ENTERING OR LEAVING MASS**
- TRY TO AVOID USING THE **KNEELERS** IF POSSIBLE. IF ONE IS USED PLEASE LEAVE IT DOWN WHEN YOU EXIT THE BENCH SO IT CAN BE CLEANED.
- **BY LAW YOU MUST NOW WEAR A MASK IN CHURCH PLEASE REMEMBER TO BRING IT**
- **HAND SANITISE** AS YOU **ENTER** AND AS YOU **LEAVE** THE CHURCH.
- THE **TOILETS ARE LOCKED**
- COMMUNION **ONLY ON THE HAND.**
- TAKE CARE TO MAINTAIN THE 2 METRES DISTANCING FROM OTHERS, AT ALL TIMES, INCLUDING THE MINISTER OF COMMUNION.

OUR CHURCH NEEDS THE HELP OF STEWARDS TO ENSURE EVERYONE IS KEPT SAFE.

STEWARDS DO NOT COUNT IN THE 20 ATTENDING

THE OPENING OF THE CHURCH FOR MASS IS TOTALLY DEPENDENT ON HAVING ENOUGH VOLUNTEER STEWARDS FOR EVERY MASS.
